
NSF FARMS - NORTH DAKOTA ADVANCED AGRICULTURE TECHNOLOGY ENGINE

In January, the U.S. National Science Foundation awarded FARMS core partners-North Dakota State University, the North Dakota Tribal College System, the Greater Fargo Moorhead Economic Development Corporation, Fargo Moorhead West Fargo Chamber Foundation, and Grand Farm-up to \$15 million over the next two years, with the potential for a total of \$160 million over a decade through the Regional Innovation Engines program.

The regional partnership, called Food systems Adapted for Resiliency and Maximized Security (FARMS), was named an award winner out of 188 concept outlines originally submitted throughout the U.S. This funding is designed to accelerate innovation that solves food insecurity and cross-cultural engagement through AgTech innovation. This group of core partners inspired stakeholders from across the region to create, collaborate, and accelerate a platform that engages intentional interactions, formalizes AgTech innovation projects and investment, and solves real world food challenges, all centered on improving crosscultural relationships across the state.

GROW HORIZONS

This event focused on intentionally supporting the **BIPOC** population of the Fargo-Moorhead area by learning about challenges and identifying ways of supporting careers in AgTech



EDUCONNECT. **TECHCONNECT, & SPACECONNECT**

In connection with our annual conferences, we hosted education-focused workshops for educators and students, provided bus tours of real AgTech facilities allowing direct conversations with leaders, and hosted startups and industry folks to connect with students and educators to provide career options.

n 2024, Grand Farm focused on building deeper relationships with our partners, fostering stronger collaboration to tackle agricultural challenges. By enhancing engagement, we worked closely with the different groups in our ecosystem to create impactful solutions.

GROWER PAIN POINTS

Identifying and addressing growers' challenges is central to Grand Farm's mission. We focus on the needs of the upper Midwest while leveraging global innovation to develop actionable solutions for agriculture. By collaborating with growers, commodity councils, grower associations, and stakeholders, we gather insights, prioritize pain points, and ensure our efforts remain aligned with the most pressing needs in the agricultural ecosystem.





STARTUP ECOSYSTEM

Grand Farm's startup ecosystem thrived in 2024, creating meaningful opportunities for startups to develop and refine their agricultural innovations. The inaugural Startup Plots program welcomed six startups from locations as far-reaching as Utah, Canada, and Costa Rica, providing a dedicated space for testing and building connections. Additionally, Grand Farm featured startup pitches on stage at all of its annual conferences, offering founders a platform to showcase their solutions to key stakeholders and potential collaborators.

COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

Innovation-as-a-Service advances agricultural innovation at Grand Farm by facilitating projects, promoting collaboration, and guiding technology development. In 2024, efforts included the Palmer Amaranth Project, which began the process of developing AI tools to detect and mitigate the spread of this harmful weed. Regular drone flights and sensor deployments also provided valuable data insights for field plots, enhancing research and technology validation.





FEATURED PROJECT

SENSOR SANDBOX


Piloted in 2024, the Sensor Sandbox is Grand Farm's innovative initiative to explore the potential of IoT (Internet of Things) sensors in precision agriculture. This cutting-edge testing ground enables the collection of realtime, actionable farm data to address critical challenges in modern farming.

The project focuses on:

Testing Communication Protocols: Evaluating connectivity solutions like LoRaWAN, Cellular, and Private Cellular (4G) in rural environments. **Assessing Sensor Types:** Piloting sensors to gather data such as soil moisture, nitrogen levels, and weather conditions.

Demonstrating Practical Use: Showcasing how real-time and historical data optimize practices like irrigation and field management.

UGA GRAND FARM

UGA Grand Farm, a partnership between Grand Farm and the University of Georgia College of Agricultural & Environmental Sciences, will serve as an AgTech innovation hub for the Southeast, providing space to test, demonstrate, and validate new technologies. By hosting events and programs, we aim to connect growers, industry, policymakers, and students with innovations to advance agriculture for future generations.

In 2024, we secured access to a 250-acre site, finalized plans for irrigation systems, and began construction on our first building, opening Spring 2025. We also hired our first employee to oversee development and built key partnerships.





ENGAGING TECHNOLOGISTS

Emerging Digital Academy (EDA) is a 20week immersive coding bootcamp that equips students with the skills needed for entry-level software development roles. Our mission is to bridge the technology workforce gap by cultivating a new generation of skilled developers and fostering a connected, supportive tech community. In 2024, Emerging Digital Academy launched several new initiatives, including the co-op internship program, and graduated three cohorts (Leavitt, Minsky, and Neumann), marking a significant year of growth and community impact.

was a milestone year for Emerging Digital Academy as we continued to grow and evolve. We graduated 22 students from our full-stack development program and launched a co-op internship initiative. providing more hands-on learning opportunities. Our impact extended beyond the Black Building with a pilot auxiliary program in partnership with the Pelican Rapids school district. We also hosted our largest in-person cohort to date, highlighting the increasing demand for our program and the growth of our community.

Looking to 2025, we aim to expand our programs, strengthen internship partnerships, and refine our curriculum with feedback from industry partners. Our employer network remains central to our success, and we anticipate a vear of innovation, collaboration, and arowth. We're grateful to our mentors. employers, and community partners for supporting a program that fosters technical talent and meaningful connections."

In 2024, Emerging Digital Academy focused on building tangible pathways into the workforce for its students. A cornerstone of this effort was the launch of the co-op internship program, which allows students to gain hands-on experience in real-world settings while providing employers with a flexible hiring model that reduces risks. This year alone, **nine new employers** joined the program, offering students invaluable opportunities to apply their skills and gain meaningful work experience. To further align the program with industry needs, our team initiated a survey of local tech companies to identify the skills and technologies most sought after by employers. Insights from the survey will inform future curriculum updates, positioning Emerging Digital Academy students to meet the evolving demands of the tech industry.

Riley's resilience and dedication led him to a co-op internship with local startup Kirkwall, led by EDA alumnus Ujjwal Adikhari, where he was one of five interns. At the end of the summer, Riley was offered a full-time position—a testament to his commitment and skill.

Throughout 2024, Emerging Digital Academy strengthened its ties within the local tech community and formed new partnerships that enhanced opportunities for our graduates. A partnership with **Bell Bank** led to the hiring of two Emerging Digital Academy interns, while collaboration with the NDSU Research and Technology Park provided graduates with direct connections to startups seeking tech talent. Additionally, in response to the challenging job market, Emerging Digital Academy expanded its alumni program by introducing guest speakers and workshops, offering ongoing support, training, and networking resources to graduates. StartupBREW Fargo continued bringing together entrepreneurs and innovators, with college takeovers from NDSU, Concordia, and MSUM showcasing student entrepreneurs. Partnerships with Gener8tor, 50 South Capital, and area colleges expanded resources and fueled local innovation. The Prairie Capital Summit hit record attendance, attracting investors from cities like Seattle and New York,

while the Founders Retreat provided entrepreneurs with time to recharge and reflect.

In 2025, we're launching Entrepreneur Day at the Capitol to connect founders with policymakers and planning quarterly women and BIPOC founder meetups to foster mentorship and growth. Together, these efforts will continue building a supportive, inclusive ecosystem for the next generation of Midwest entrepreneurs."

Our initiatives focus on empowering entrepreneurs through resources, networking, and communitybuilding events that champion local and regional startups. In 2024. Startup Programs expanded its reach with highimpact events. strengthened partnerships. and initiatives that brought new perspectives to the Fargo-Moorhead area and beyond.



In 2024, StartupBREW Fargo continued to be a cornerstone of our Startup Programs, bringing together entrepreneurs, innovators, and community members every Wednesday morning to share ideas, build connections, and energize the startup ecosystem. IMPACT

In 2024, Startup Programs launched impactful initiatives that broadened our reach and strengthened support for regional startups. The Startup World Cup Pitch Competition, in collaboration with Grand Farm, offered local founders a platform to showcase their ideas on a national stage, culminating in Fargo-based founder Troy Vareberg winning the regional competition and securing a spot at Pegasus Ventures' World Cup event in California. Additionally, our Women Who Scale event brought together inspiring voices like Betsy Fore, a serial venture-backed founder, and Amanda Schneider, President of ThinkLab, who shared their experiences as scaling female founders, inspiring the next generation of women entrepreneurs.

Through partnerships with key organizations, Startup Programs expanded access to mentorship, resources, and funding, empowering founders to take bold steps in their ventures. These initiatives continue to build momentum for a thriving entrepreneurial ecosystem in the Midwest.

FOUNDER HIGHLIGHTS

2024 saw exciting success stories from regional founders engaged with Startup Programs. Bryce Wuori, past StartupBREW speaker, has gained attention in the industry, speaking at SXSW in Austin and scaling his company, Pavewise, through investments and local accelerator support. Lisa Esberger, founder of Verdethos, relocated her business to Fargo to connect with Emerging Prairie's startup ecosystem. Since then, she's become deeply involved with Startup Programs and Grand Farm. Lisa has chosen the Prairie Den for Verdethos' headquarters as they launch their business and grow their leadership and software development teams.
